



## USEFUL INFORMATION

**Ciudad Real** is a small town located **198 km from Madrid** with which is connected by a direct road in very good conditions (highway) and by a **quick 50-minute trip on a nonstop high speed train**. It is located centered in “La Mancha” the land where Miguel de Cervantes got inspired to write his masterpiece **“Don Quijote de La Mancha”**.

### GETTING TO CIUDAD REAL (BY TRAIN)

The easiest and fastest way to get to Ciudad Real is by high speed train from Madrid’s Atocha Station.

All flights to Madrid arrive at Adolfo Suarez-Madrid Barajas Airport. From the airport there are several options to get to Atocha Station (located south of Madrid):

- **Subway:** The link below shows the route to follow from the airport terminals to Atocha Station:

  1. Line 8 to Nuevos Ministerios station.
  2. Change to Line 6 to Cuatro Caminos station.
  3. Change to Line 1 direction Valdecarros to Atocha station.
- Combination of Subway and **short distance train (Cercanías)**:
  1. Subway Line 8 to Nuevos Ministerios station.
  2. Change to a short distance train (Cercanías) to Atocha Station: see below the short distance trains' (Cercanías) map

Note that there are High Speed trains from Barcelona so it is also feasible to fly into Barcelona. However, the train tickets to Ciudad Real would be more expensive in this case.

### From Madrid:
